




# Louisiana Lodging

### Occupancy (%): Quarterly Yr/Yr



- Louisiana's occupancy increased by 29% from January to March 2024.
- Louisiana's occupancy is slightly down 1.1% over last March.

- Louisiana's average daily rates (ADR) had an 11% increase from January to March 2024.
- ADR is grew 7% since March 2019.

• Louisiana's occupancy, excluding New Orleans, increased 26.7% from January to March 2024.



ADR (\$) without NOLA: Quarterly Yr/Yr




• Louisiana's ADR, excluding New Orleans, grew 9% from January to March 2024.

# Short-Term Lodging


### **Short-Term Lodging Occupancy (%): Quarterly Yr/Yr**



- Louisiana's short-term lodging occupancy increased by 46% from January to March 2024.
- Booked listings are up 9.6% over last March.

- RevPar (revenue per available room) was up 9.3% over March 2023.



#### Tourism Jobs (in thousands): Quarterly Yr/Yr




- Louisiana's leisure & hospitality industry were slight down 0.5% from January to March 2024.

#### Website Visits: Quarterly Yr/Yr




- Nearly 1.5 million website visits from January to March 2024.

### Welcome Centers Visitation: Quarterly Yr/Yr




• Louisiana's welcome centers visits increased 65.5% from January to March 2024.

### Louisiana Economic Impact and U.S. Travel Sentiment

- Louisiana's travel spending generated \$1.13 billion in February 2024, an increase of 2.3% over last year and an 7.3% increase since 2019. (*Tourism Economics*)
- 30% of American travelers have taken a trip with their pets in the past 12 months. (Future Partners)
- One out of five (22%) of American travelers say they are planning to travel to see the eclipse on April 8<sup>th</sup>, with 14% of them indicating they expect to travel greater than 50 miles to view this rare event, which literally means millions of travelers! (Longwoods International)
- Road trip travel to visit friends and family still leads the way over personal getaways in upcoming trips planned by American travelers. (Longwoods International)
