Falgout co-founded the Blue Moon Saloon & Guesthouse in 2001, and became its sole owner in 2005. The Blue Moon Saloon has become one of Lafayette's premier roots music venues. This world famous honky tonk is a home-grown place where all kinds and sizes are welcome, the Saloon is more than a venue or a gig. It has become a meeting place where world travelers, community organizations, families, artists and politicians rub elbows, dance, drink a few and thank their lucky stars they have the good fortune to spend an evening together in Lafayette, Louisiana. The saloon served as some of the inspriation for the Louisiana float performance stage!

Mark was President of Festival International de Louisiane and has promoted Louisiana culture nationally and internationally through his companies, EXPO Louisiane and Blue Moon Music Group.

In 2015, Mark founded Warehouse 535, a unique special event center in the heart of downtown Lafayette.
