


December Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

December ADR (\$): Yr/Yr




• Louisiana's average daily rates (ADR) grew 1.0% over December 2023.

Louisiana Lodging (without New Orleans)


December Occupancy (%) without NOLA: Yr/Yr

December ADR (\$) without NOLA: Yr/Yr




• Louisiana's ADR, excluding New Orleans, grew by 3.4% over December 2023.

December Short-Term Rental Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr




- Louisiana's short-term lodging occupancy decreased 3.8% over December 2023.

December Short-Term Rental ADR (\$): Yr/Yr




- Louisiana's short-term lodging ADR grew 1.1% over December 2023.

December Tourism Jobs (in thousands): Yr/ Yr




- Tourism jobs increased 0.4% over November 2024.


- Total users are up 8% over December 2023.

December Welcome Centers Visitation: Yr/Yr




Over December 2023, Louisiana welcome centers average travel party stayed 2.81 nights.

Louisiana and U.S. Travel Sentiment & Trends

- Louisiana saw an increase of 4.9% in air passengers over November 2023. (TSA; Airline Data, Inc.)
- 41% of American travelers are likely to take an international trip in 2025. (Longwoods International)
- The majority of American travelers said they find slowcations (57%), foodie trips (57%), and experiential travel (55.9%) to be appealing for a 2025 trip. (Future Partners)
- Over 119 million Americans are expected to hit the road, 50 miles or more, or take to the skies, surpassing pre-pandemic levels. (AAA)
- Sports travel was valued at \$564.7 billion in 2023 and is expected to reach \$1.33 trillion by 2032. Music travel
 is projected to hit \$13.8 billion within the next decade. (Skift)
- The 2025 wave season for cruise line sales is projected to be robust, with passenger numbers expected to surpass 30 million for the first time. (Seeking Alpha)
