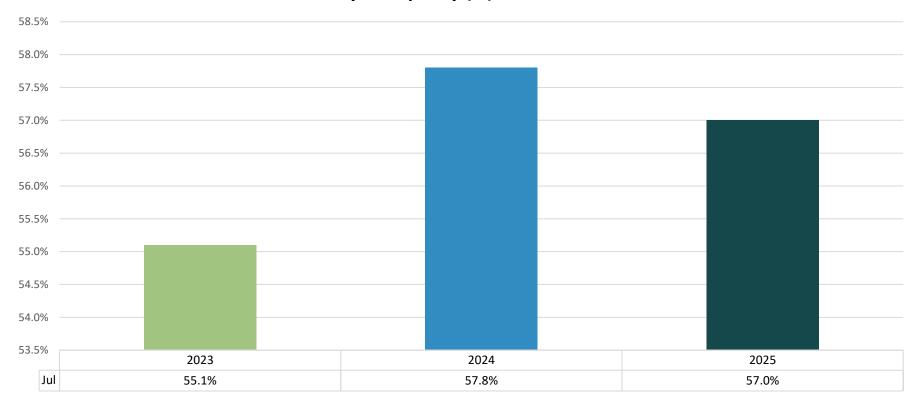






Louisiana Lodging

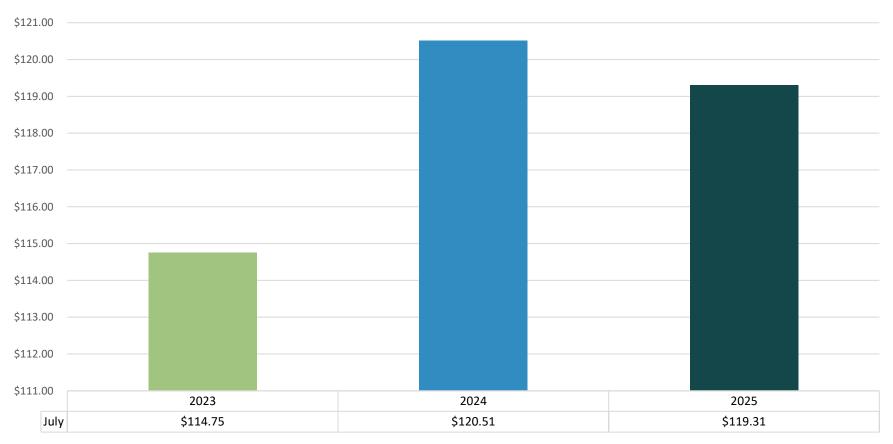
July Occupancy (%): Yr/Yr

July ADR (\$): Yr/Yr

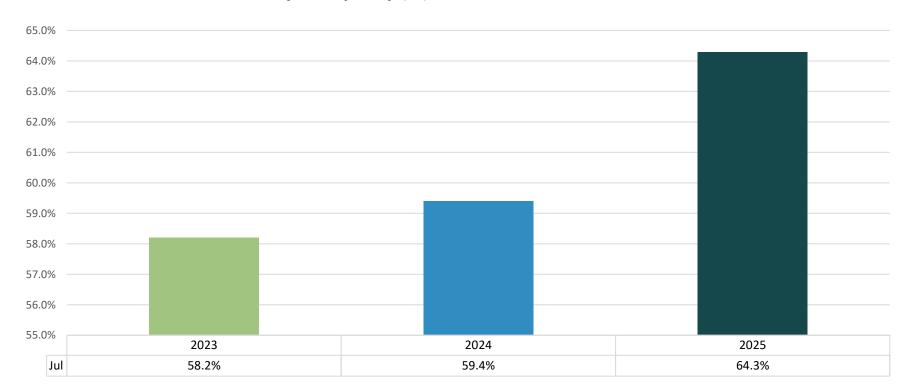


- Louisiana's average daily rates (ADR) declined by 1% over July 2024.

July Occupancy (%) without NOLA: Yr/Yr

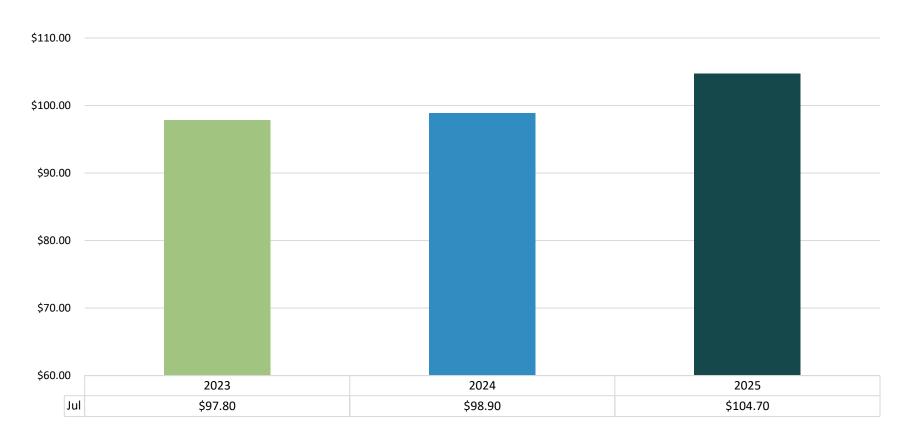


• Louisiana's occupancy, excluding New Orleans, increased by 8.2% over July 2024.

July ADR (\$) without NOLA: Yr/Yr



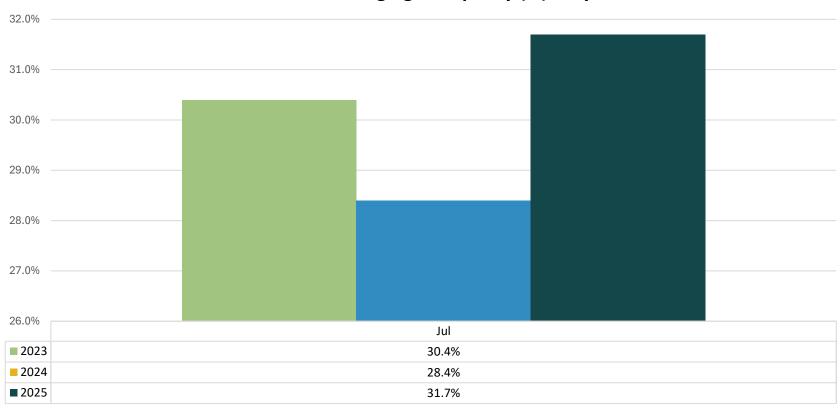
• Louisiana's ADR, excluding New Orleans, grew by 5.9% over July 2024.

Short-Term Lodging Occupancy (%): July

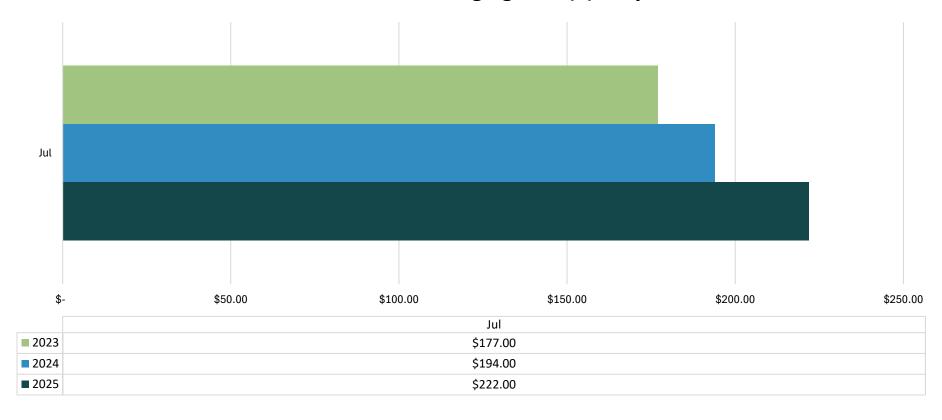


- Louisiana's short-term lodging occupancy increased 12% over July 2024.

Short-Term Lodging ADR (\$): July



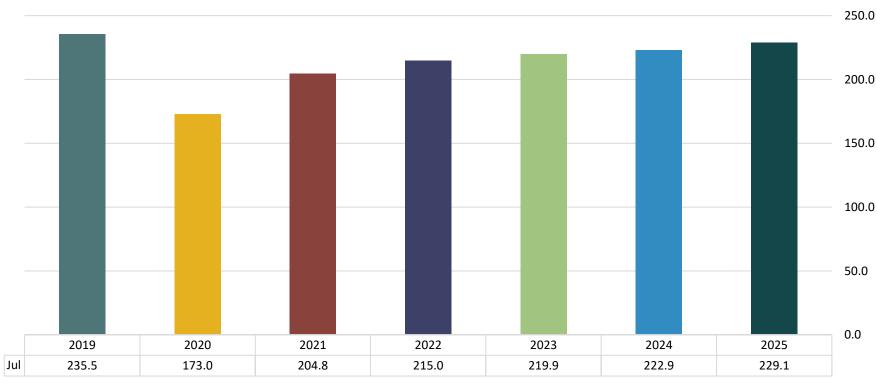
- Louisiana's short-term lodging ADR grew 15% over July 2024.

Louisiana Leisure & Hospitality Jobs



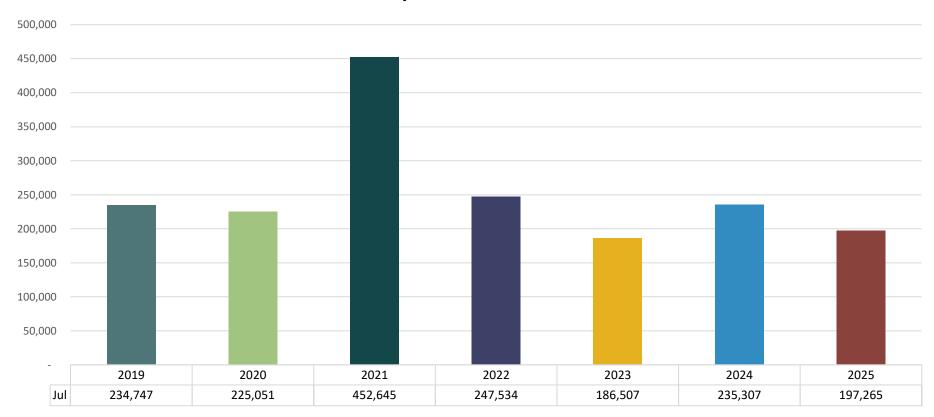


- Tourism jobs increased by 2.8% with a gain of 6,200 jobs over July 2024.

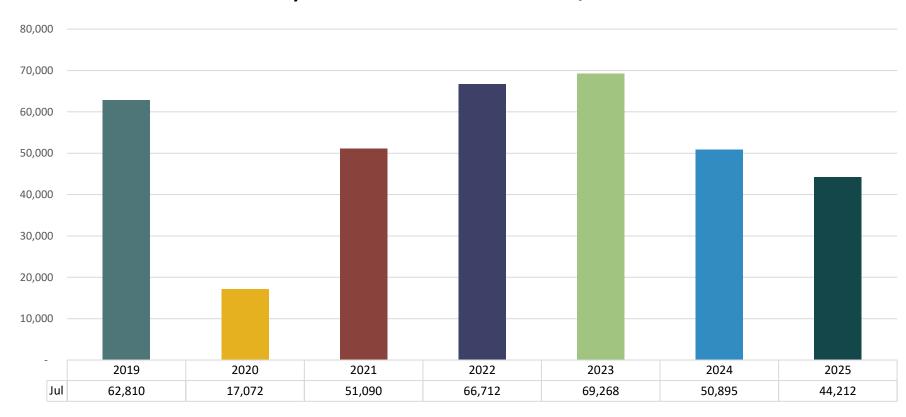
- Views per session increased 1.9% over July 2024.

July Welcome Centers Visitation: Yr/Yr

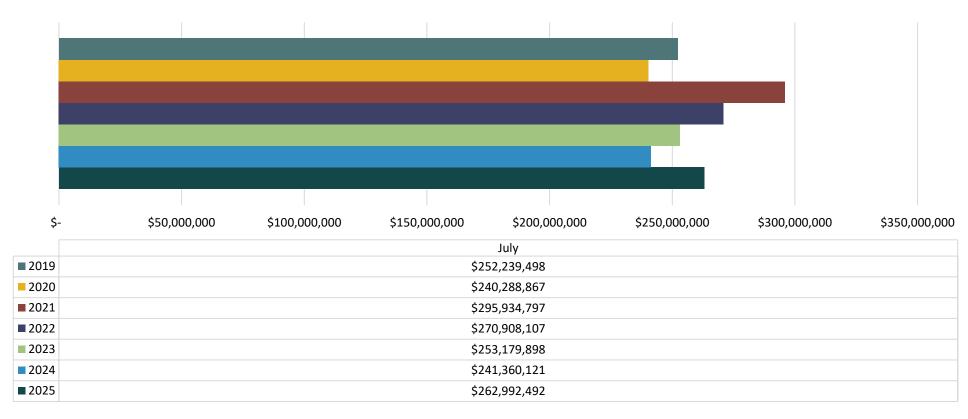


• In July 2025, Louisiana welcome centers received a 14% increase of visitors from Pennsylvania, over last July.

U.S. Travel Sentiment & Trends

- Labor Day travel is expected to be cheaper across the board for Americans this year. (AAA)
- 56% of American travelers have spent at least one night following a touring route or scenic/historic
 highway in the U.S., such as Route 66, the Pacific Coast Highway, Blue Ridge Parkway or any other Scenic
 Byway. (Longwoods International)
- More Americans are opting for road trips this summer, with a record 60% planning to travel by car.
 Popular destinations include national parks and local culinary experiences. (Enterprise Mobility)
- Tour operators are boosting their North America portfolios in response to rising interest from travelers seeking guided experiences closer to home. (Travel Weekly)
- Due to travel patterns shifting, demand peaking earlier in the year and some travelers booking last minute, US airlines have reduced August capacity by 6% compared to July, leading to higher airfares. (CNBC)
- 57% of travelers plan to spend the same or more on travel. (YouGov)
